

Geneva State Park Campground

Reservations are recommended, call 1-866-644-6727 or visit www.ohiostateparks.org.

Camping is first come, first served for sites that are not reserved.

Our 79 reservable sites are 9-69 & 76-93; these are marked "reservable" in green on the site posts.

Our 21 walk-in sites are 1-8; 70-75 & 94-100; these are marked "walk-in" in red on the site posts.

If you have a reservation, please stop at the camp office to pick up your passes.

If you are a "walk-in" camper (without reservations), you may register for up to 14 nights if sites are available.

WHEN THE CAMP OFFICE IS CLOSED

All campers are required to complete the self-registration form located in the mail box near the building's drive-up window.

Reservation Holders: enter your name & reservation number on a self-registration form and deposit the form in the self service pay station at the camp office.

Campers Without Reservations: register on an unoccupied "walk-in" site for up to 14 nights; or on an unoccupied "reservable" site for one (1) night only. If you wish to stay longer on a reservable site, you must come to the camp office in the morning. Enclose payment and deposit the envelope in the self service pay station - north side of the camp office - within one hour of arrival.

CAMPING FEES & RULES

- ❖ If you camp on a site where electricity is provided, you must pay that site's fee even if you don't use the service.
- ❖ Please check-out or renew your site by 1:00pm. Check-in time is 3:00pm.
- ❖ Maximum stay in the campground is 14 days in a 30 day period.
- ❖ Maximum occupancy is 6 people per site, including adults and children.
- ❖ Pets are permitted on all sites except 53 through 69. Maximum of 2 pets per site.
- ❖ If you wish to receive or use your rewards points (please make sure you have enough points), please include your rewards card number.
- ❖ We require payment before you retire for the evening - Thank you.

Standard camp sites #1-87, 89 & 91:

\$28.00 per night Sunday through Thursday nights.

\$29.00 per night Friday & Saturday nights (starting Memorial Day weekend thru Labor Day weekend)

\$30.00 per night Friday, Saturday & Sunday nights of Memorial Day and Labor Day and July 3rd & 4th.

Full-service sites # 88, 90 & 92: (Available May 1 though October 31)

\$33.00 per night Sunday through Thursday nights.

\$34.00 per night Friday & Saturday nights (starting Memorial Day weekend thru Labor Day weekend)

\$35.00 per night Friday, Saturday & Sunday nights of Memorial Day and Labor Day and July 3rd & 4th.

Overflow sites # 94-100: (no electricity)

\$20.00 per night Sunday through Thursday nights.

\$21.00 per night Friday & Saturday nights (starting Memorial Day weekend thru Labor Day weekend)

\$22.00 per night Friday, Saturday & Sunday nights of Memorial Day and Labor Day and July 3rd & 4th.

- ❖ Ohio residents with Golden Buckeye Cards receive a 50% discount Sunday through Thursday nights and 10% discount Friday & Saturday nights.
- ❖ Ohio residents who are 100% disabled veterans or former POWs who have certification from the Veteran's Administration receive free camping.
- ❖ Sites 1-93 have a 40' paved parking pad. Flush toilets, hot showers and laundry facilities are available. All sites have a picnic table and fire ring. Please do not move fire rings.
- ❖ A 2 mile paved trail connects the campground and the cabins to the beach, other park facilities and the village of Geneva-on-the-lake.
- ❖ The beach is located 1/2 mile east of the campground.
- ❖ Parking - all vehicles must be parked single file on the camping pad, not on the grass or roadway. Boat trailers are permitted on the grass at your site. Tow vehicle must remain on the pavement at all times. Visitor's vehicles that do not fit on the camping pad must be parked in the North visitor's lot.
- ❖ Speed limit is 10 mph. Visitors are permitted until 10:00pm.
- ❖ Quiet hours are from 10:00pm to 6:00am. Generators must be turned off by 10:00pm.
- ❖ Drive through passes are required and are valid for 15 minutes.
- ❖ Juvenile campers must provide written permission from their parents to camp alone.
- ❖ Our Campground Hosts are at site 93, see them or a Park Officer for information and assistance.
- ❖ Winter Rates are \$2 less from November 1 - March 31.
- ❖ Recycling - please do your part to recycle during your stay. One recycling container is centrally located for your use along the road just north of the showerhouse.
